And Finally, From Finance

From Finance

2023 was a challenging year for Arrow in a number of areas, including finance. Our team worked extremely hard to stretch every dollar to its greatest missional effectiveness.

We saw reduced donor support throughout 2023, with the cost-of-living crisis amid interest rate hikes having a significant flow-on effect to charitable giving. Arrow experienced these effects twice-over; firstly, we felt the reduction of direct donation support. Secondly, we saw lower program participant numbers (and accordingly reduced program revenue) as the churches and non-profit organisations from where we draw our participants experienced lower giving, restricting the leadership development investments these same organisations can make in their upcoming leaders through Arrow. Our overall revenue for 2023 was 21% down from 2022 levels.

Despite our ongoing efforts in further reducing overheads and operational costs, we returned an operating loss (after partnership fund adjustment) of \$143,000, a significant deviation from our budgeted operating surplus of \$30,000. Following the draw on our general reserves in 2023, we retained \$159,000 in general reserves to carry forward to 2024. This level of reserves is minimally sufficient to meet our protection reserve requirements, but does not provide us with optimisation reserves to pursue new opportunities.

For those familiar with our previous Annual Reviews, you won't be surprised to know that staff costs were again our largest investment,

representing approximately 53% of our expenses in 2023. With the unexpected reduction in both donations and program revenue during 2023, difficult conversations around the size of our staff team were required, and we move into 2024 with a smaller staff team.

While overall donations were down in 2023, we remain encouraged by the generosity of those with the capacity and calling to partner with Arrow through financial support. As an organisation that is in part donor supported, we recognise the trust placed in us as we Build Leaders and Build Leadership across Australia. In whatever form you support Arrow, we thank you.
